What is all about the LASIK laser eye surgery?

LASIK (Laser-Assisted in Situ Keratomileusis In ure in which laser energy

Situ) is a procedure in which laser energy is used to alter the curvature of human cornea, in order to neutralise the refractive error of the eye. The procedure eliminates the requirement of spectacles or contact lenses for attaining clear vision.

CATARACT SURGERY IS DONE ON DAY CARE BASIS

How does Vasan Eye Care Hospital provide services beyond restoration of eyesight and also improve the normal facial appearance?

Restoration of sight is the primary goal of Ophthalmology. However, scope of opthalmology does not end here. There are certain conditions/ diseases associated with eye that affects the appearance of eye and causes facial disfigurement. Vasan Eye Care Hospital provides services to take care of this group of disorder as well. Most of these patients develop disfigurement of eye/face

following trauma, while others are born with such deformity. Aging changes also start from the eyes area and the person may appear older than he/she is. We provide aesthetic surgery for eyes to help restore the young eye/face appearance.

When should the patient consider for cataract surgery?

Cataract is clouding of the eye's natural lens. It is a natural process of ageing. Every individual gets it sooner or later.

Cataract impairs focusing of light on the retina and hence blurs vision. Old age is the most common cause of cataract. It also sometimes occurs relatively early in life due to factors such as injury, excessive sunlight, toxic chemicals, diseases, such as glaucoma and inflammation. There can be hereditary predisposition to earlier occurrence of cataracts.

What happens during the cataract surgery?
The decision to treat a cataract is made together

by the eye care practitioner and the patient. It is based on the degree to which the cataract is impairing vision and the effect of the impairment on the patient's quality of life. The clouded cataractous lens is extracted by fragmenting it into tiny pieces with ultrasound energy and aspirated out with a suction device. The cataract is removed through a small self-sealing wound. There are no sutures applied on the eye. Now-a-days cataract surgery is done on day care basis. Topical anaesthesia (in the form of eye drops) is used.

Phacoemulsification technique is used to emulsify and remove the cataract and foldable intraocular lens is implanted. We prefer MICS (corneal incision-1 .8mm) to conventional phaco (corneal incision-2.8mm).

Macular degeneration affects the macula, the part of the eyes that allows you to see fine details. Regular eye checkup can help you to diagnose the disease early. The vision is lost in the condition if it is complicated

by CNVM (a condition in which the central retina is damaged). If this condition is diagnosed early, it can be cured with good results with anti-VEGF injections or photodynamic therapy.

What are the surgical advances in cases of retinal detachments surgeries?

Treatment for retinal detachment which was once used to be very difficult with poor visual outcomes has witnessed a sea change in past few years with the advent of small gauge surgeries (which do not even require sutures) and high cut rate vitrectomy machines. With these technologies, surgical time has reduced, patients is more comfortable post operatively, chances of complications has reduced and visual outcomes are much better.

ANATOMY AROUND EYE IS VERY COMPACT AND CRITICAL

What is all about the art of cosmetic, revisional and reconstructive oculoplastic surgery??

Cosmetic eye surgery includes aesthetic surgery that improves the appearance of the eye and face. There is no problem with the eye or vision the aim of these surgeries is to make you beautiful/handsome. Reconstructive surgery is mainly indicated in cases of trauma or birth defect where part of the eyelids or surrounding structure is damaged or missing. Reconstructive sur-
