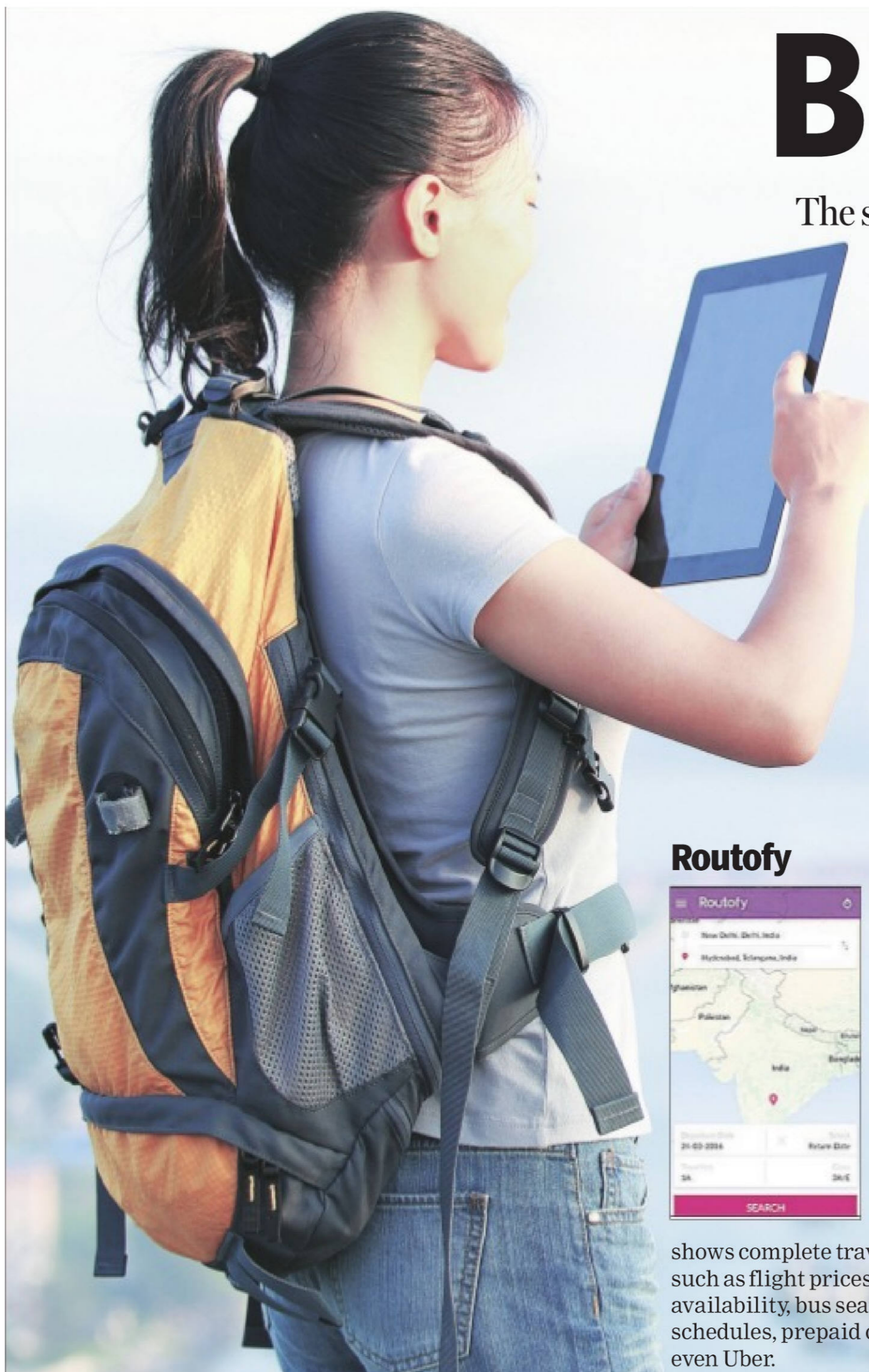


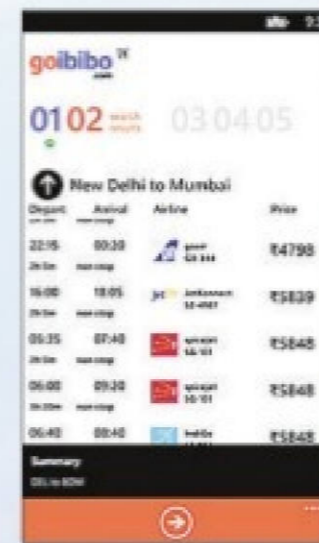

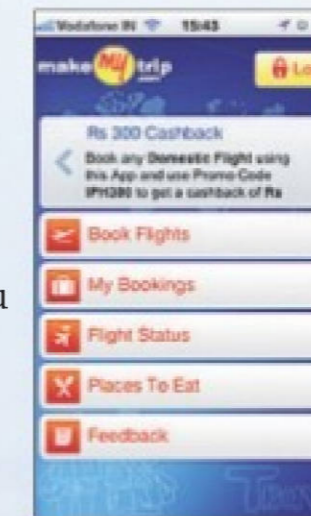
Goibibo

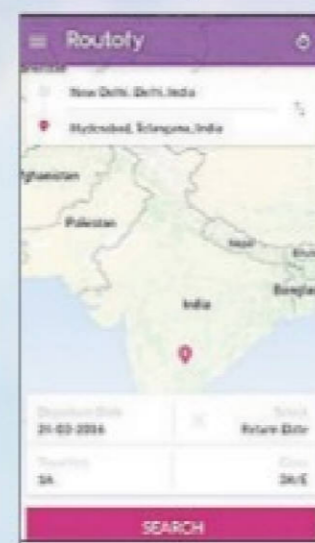


Revv

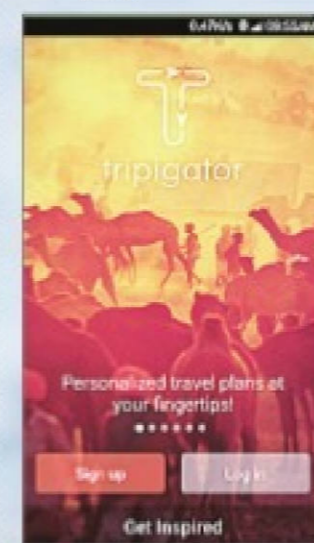
Routofy

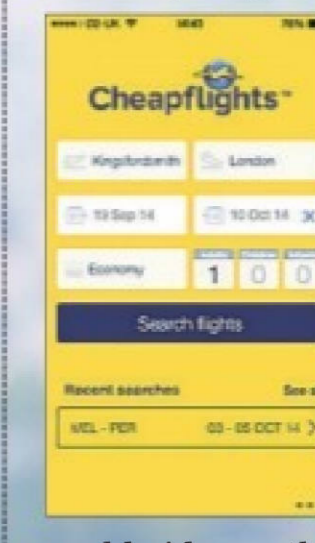
Tripoto
